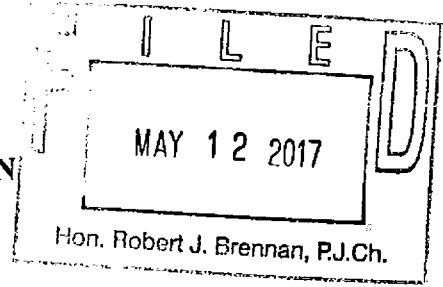

1. The defendants' motion to modify the restraints granted in the court's Order of January 19, 2017 is granted.

2. The defendants may collect the easement assessment from any property owner, who voluntarily pays the assessment.

3. The defendants may release from escrow the easement assessment paid by any property owner, who advises the defendants ^{in writing} that the property owner wants the easement assessment, currently held in escrow, to be released to the defendants.

4. A copy of this Order shall be served on all counsel within 7 days of the date of this Order.
