**Call the Governor's Office and ask the Governor to
VETO S3661/A5043. 1-609-292-6000**

You are likely not aware that legislation (S3661/A5043) has been fast tracked and approved through the NJ State Assembly that will, in essence, cause the immediate and irreversible decline of impacted community association managed lakes in NJ.

This legislation will only prevent lake associations from collecting member fees to support their budgets, which is needed to properly maintain the lakes and surrounding properties.

Other property or homeowners associations are still allowed to collect fees, but not lakes!

If a lake association cannot raise the funds needed via property owners, then the association fails. Lake water quality declines, algae and weeds take hold, the smell and mosquitoes become rampant and eventually the body that once held water can be sold to the highest bidder.

Our only hope is to rally together to ensure this legislation gets stopped at the Governor's desk.

Please, keep reaching out to the Governor's Office and tell the Governor that you are AGAINST S3661/A5043. You can call several times.

Our lake will not survive otherwise!

Other projects that were completed so you can all enjoy your time at the lake:


- Drewes Beach temporary repair. Bob Bailey worked through many rainy days to have this done in time for Open House. He even had some sand to put on volleyball court.






GARDEN CLUB




