

By now you should start receiving invoices for your 2024 membership fees or, as FirstService Residential calls it, a statement. Along with the statement for your 2024 membership, you will see a few letters in the envelope, copies of those letters and a sample invoice are in this newsletter.

Expect to receive the following items in the mail in one envelope from FirstService Residential:

- Statement (this is your invoice)
- "READ THIS FIRST"
- LPPOA Welcome Letter
- Boat Tags and Parking Enforcement
- Optional Premium Flyer
- Please go to this link, https://lakeparsippanypoa.connectresident.com/
- Click Login if you already have an account and pay.
- Create Account if you don't already have one.
- Then please enter your Name and Property Address. Then follow prompts for payment.
- You can pay either \$140 or \$340 or \$325 (seniors who wants Premium).

If you initially opt for the easement/Basic fee only and decide later that you do want more access to beaches and other amenities available to Premium Members as noted in the welcome letter, you can always choose to upgrade your membership for the additional \$200.00. For any questions or concerns regarding payment or any other questions please contact our Property

The most important letter you should read first is the one that says "READ THIS FIRST". This will explain to you how our fees are structured. Which fee amount is mandatory and optional.

PAY BY CREDIT CARD OR E-CHECK:

If you have not done so already, we invite you to create your account at https://lakeparsippanypoa.connectresident.com, click on Make Payment, which will take you FirstService's payment processing provider, ClickPay, to start making payments online. Once registered, you can make payments by e-check (ACH) from a bank checking account with no fee or by credit/debit card for an additional nominal fee.

\$140.00 mandatory easement & \$200.00 amenities & recreation & qualifies for senior discount.

If this option is selected you will have access to all amenities and recreation use.

SENIOR DISCOUNT -(OPTIONAL PREMIUM ONLY):

The rate of \$325.00 includes the following:

\$140.00 mandatory easement and \$200.00 for amenities less the \$15.00 discount.

If you want access to all amenities & recreation you will pay \$15 less of the \$340 which comes to **\$325**.

If you do not want Premium please just pay **\$140**

2024 BOAT & PARKING TAGS INFORMATION

- You must pick up Boat Tags at the clubhouse.
- Dates & times will be posted on the clubhouse door, online, website, social media, news letter and email will be sent.
- To obtain your Boat Tags your account must be current (in good standing) with no monies owed to the Ippoa.

BOAT TAGS

If you place any type of water vessel on the LPPOA property you must have your 2024 boat tag on the water vessel. Any water vessel found on the LPPOA property without a 2024 boat tag will be removed and put in storage. To recover your water vessel, you must bring your 2024 boat tag to adhere to the water vessel and a payment of \$75.00.

All water vessels must be removed from the LPPOA property by **November 15, 2024**. Any water vessel not picked up will be removed and put in storage. To recover your vessel there will be a fee of \$75.00.

PARKING TAGS

Every property owner in good standing will receive 2 parking tags. All LPPOA parking is first come first serve. If any vehicle is found on the LPPOA property without a 2023 Parking Tag the vehicle will be towed at the vehicle owner's expense.

LPPOA 2024 WELCOME LETTER

January, 2024

Dear Property Owner

On behalf of the Lake Parsippany Property Owners Association (LPPOA) we welcome you to our community. Many of you we have known for years, and many of you will be new faces, but we look forward to meeting all of you, whether it is walking around our lake, at the beach or at one of the many community activities we have planned for 2024.

LPPOA was founded in 1933 and has undergone much change. Gone are the unpaved streets and the summer bungalow community it was back then. We are now a full time community with over 2200 homes. The operation of this Association is governed by a Board of elected/appointed volunteer directors. We have worked tirelessly to create our membership structure and fees to be fair for the entire community. Many Members are in different stages of their lives (those who want to enjoy everything that the lake has to offer and those who may not). Based on beach utilization numbers from last year, the Board has come to realize that a majority of the homeowners aren't interested in beach access. There are different interests, so membership addressed that.

The Board has voted to assess a 2024 Member fee to pay for maintenance and upkeep of the LPPOA common property. The fee for the 2024 annual property owner's member fee is based on the Basic \$383,700 and Amenities Premium \$93,740, to be shared by the 2204 property owners in this lake community. The Amenities premium rate of \$340 is charges for full access usage of LPPOA common property. For homeowners who wish not to use full amenities offered by the association, a reduced rate of \$140 is available. The statement will indicate the \$340 amount. If you are interested in waiving access to these amenities, you can pay the reduced amount of \$140. Payment in full is due by March 31; after March 31, all delinquent accounts will be assessed a \$10

late payment charge per month. Only Property Owners in Good Standing (no balance owed) retain privileges of LPPOA, including the right to vote and the ability to run for open Board positions. Committee participation is open and encouraged for all members in good standing. Members, in good standing, will receive in the mail 2 parking tags. Membership cards from last year are being reused. New Members can pick up cards at the clubhouse. Lost cards are replaced at the clubhouse for a nominal fee. For Property Owners with a larger household of more than 4 members, additional cards provided for verified family members living in the home at the Clubhouse during operating hours. Boats tags will be provided to you upon request at the Clubhouse during operating hours.

All property owners in good standing can enjoy full participation designated by their member plan in the LPPOA. Good standing is defined as members who are up to date with both current year dues as well as all past years' dues. Premium Plan members (i.e., those who have not waived additional amenity access) enjoy the full use of all LPPOA facilities including use of the beach, involvement in Hub Lakes and can sign up to take swim lessons for a nominal fee. We encourage all members in good standing to participate in the many events planned for 2024 such as family fun, sunsets at the beach, community-building activities, cultural celebration events and clubhouse social events. Only Premium Plan Members may purchase day guest passes for the beach. When bringing a guest to the beach remember that you are fully responsible for your quests. While using the lake's facilities you will be asked to provide your membership card as well as other identification that may be requested.

Please remember, your membership is yours, it is not transferable. Your membership extends to all permanent occupants of your primary residence. If your Lake property is not your primary residence, any renters of your Lake property must purchase their own Non-Property Owner membership to participate in any LPPOA activities, including fishing and boating.

To register and pay on-line go to https://LakeParsippanyPOA.connectresident.com and look for Create Account. At this site you can register and pay for membership. Once you have completed the registration process, be sure to go back in and register all of your family members for activities that interest them as well. Remember that many of the events and activities require online registration; you wouldn't want to miss out!

We encourage you to pay your statement here as it not only saves the Association with bookkeeping fees, but it ensures that we have your email address so that you can receive our monthly News and Views and we can keep you informed about the happenings in our community.


Additional common privileges for Basic and Premium members.

- Fishing from shoreline or from boats (current NJ State Fresh water Fishing License required-Ages 16-69. NJ Freshwater Angling Regulations must be observed/followed)
- Access to sailing, kayak, model yacht regattas, and other member clubs, use of boathouse and boathouse property.
- Boating, with an annual boat tag permitted. Boat storage also permitted for members with boat tags. Parking and access to boat launch sites included.
- Drewes and Johnson beach and Clubhouse rental for private parties or get together at a discounted rate.

With your full Premium Membership your entire family living in the home in the original purchase tract can participate in as many sports as you like for the season.

Hub Lakes League, which our lake has been a part of for some 60 years participates in many of the sports offerings. Hub Lakes League is made up of many neighboring lakes throughout Morris County. We compete in various sports throughout the year. It is a friendly, sometimes competitive league for all skill levels. Each week we play at another lake making lots of memories and new friends.

Lake Parsippany has many active teams and are looking to grow our presence in the league. Please reply quickly as the Volunteer Board members will be working on schedules for the season in March.

Hub Lakes Sports (Cont.)

We currently participate In:

SWIM TEAM: Meets are Monday nights starting in June and ending with a full weekend Championship meet the first weekend in August. Swimmers learn various strokes and other swimming techniques while making new friends throughout Hub Lakes. Practice schedule varies.

MEN'S HORSESHOES: This team is made up of some great long time and new members of the lake. Matches are Fridays from June through August. The team starts practicing as soon as the weather warms up.

TABLE TENNIS: The team practices throughout the year at the clubhouse. Matches are Wednesday evenings at different clubhouses from June through August.

FAMILY TRACK AND FIELD MEET: This is a oneday event held the Saturday of Father's Day. The event is open to all ages 5 and up. From relays to miles, softball throw to shotput there is something for everyone.

BOWLING: This is a one-day event typically scheduled for September. Teams must have a mix of bowlers. We try to get bowlers with a minimum average of 150.

DARTS: The season runs from January to May. Matches are Friday evenings at different clubhouses. Must be 21 to participate.

MEN'S FAST PITCH SOFTBALL: The Season runs from May through September. Games are played Sunday Mornings. The team has made the playoffs and has won many championships over the last few years. Practice schedule varies.

MEN'S AND WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL: We have 2 people that are willing to coach both men's and women's volleyball. Players must be 15 or older to participate. Matches are Tuesday and Thursday evenings from June through August playing at different lakes throughout the season.

WOMEN'S SOFTBALL: We need players and a person to act as the Hub Lakes contact.

SOCCER: Hub Lakes is currently looking to see if there is any interest in adding soccer to the Hub Lakes Sports. Discussion is ongoing but first we need to get feedback from you.

Hub Lakes Sports is a great way to meet other members, while competing in a sport you like.

I joined the Sailing Club in 2018 and was invited by Ralph Rosamilia to join the staff the following year.


What do you enjoy about your volunteer position?


I like bringing teaching new sailors and watching them progress over the seasons. I also enjoy sailing with a group and the fellowship of the club.

THE LADIES CLUB HAD A VERY BUSY LAST FEW MONTHS.



In November we planned for our annual gift drive and cookie exchange.


